The overarching goal of the one-day exercise is to engage water and wastewater utilities, response partners, and other interdependent sectors (e.g., energy, emergency services, public health and other large water users) in a discussion about their specific roles and responsibilities in preparing for, responding to, and managing the impacts associated with a major disaster. The morning session will include stakeholder presentations followed by a facilitated roundtable discussion. All participants will receive the scenario and associated exercise materials in advance.

Objectives

- Explore and clarify the roles and responsibilities of the water sector, federal, state, and county agencies, and emergency management in responding to water and wastewater emergencies
- Examine the operational coordination and communication processes among stakeholders during water and wastewater emergency response
- Assess the process of delivering coordinated, prompt, reliable, and actionable information to the community during a water/wastewater incident
- Discuss actions and resources needed to restore water and wastewater services and identify short and long-term recovery needs
