The City of Laramie is accepting applications for a Water Treatment Worker or Operator. Under direction, to perform a variety of skilled work involved in the operation, maintenance, and repair of Treatment equipment and facilities, pump station equipment and facilities, wells and well fields, finished water reservoirs, pressure control stations, transmission lines and distribution system water quality.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Perform a variety of duties involved in the operation of the water treatment plant; determine and set flow rates and chemical dosages; backwash filters; remove sludge; fill chemical feeders; perform daily maintenance checks; record information.
- Inspect and maintain plant equipment.
- Perform lab work.
- Maintain programmable logic controllers and telemetry system; write and debug ladder logic code; program around equipment failures; write code for new equipment and troubleshoot sensory instrumentation.
- Maintain records of plant operations; compile and interpret data; prepare reports for regulatory agencies.
- Operate vibration, thermo and flow analyzers.
- Operate laser shaft alignment.
- File product literature, maintenance bulletins, operating instructions, invoices, educational materials, and correspondence.
- Perform the full range of duties in the assigned area of work.

EXPERIENCE REQUIRED: (Any combination equivalent to experience and training would be qualifying)

- Two years of water treatment or related experience and/or
- Equivalent to the completion of the twelfth grade supplemented by specialized training in mathematics, chemistry, or a related field.

LICENSE OR CERTIFICATE:

- Possession of, or ability to obtain, a Class IV Water Treatment and Class II Distribution Operator certificates issued by the State of Wyoming.
- Possession of, or the ability to obtain, an appropriate, valid driver's license.
